Thank you for joining us for our Red Nose Jet Ski Ride Day 2017.

The Australian Jet Ski Association is always working towards improving the general public and other water user's perception of Jet Skiers.

To make sure we uphold these values on our ride day there are a few easy, but very important factors to remember and abide by at all times.

- Distance Off regulations are present for the safety of all Jet Skiers from each other and all water users from Jet Skis. Statistically around the world most major incidents occur when a jet Ski is moving at more than 6 knots while travelling too close to another vessel or the bank. Please be sure to adhere to the distance off rules at all times.
- The path we are travelling on is at some points quite narrow. Please ensure you ride in single file and stay right to ensure we don't impact on other vessels using the channels. This also allows for an escape path for our natural inhabitants down below.
- Tides indicate we will see some very shallow water along the way. Please stay inside the channel markers at all times and follow the ride guides. If you ride in front of the ride guide you risk others accidentally following you. If you then get the markers wrong a serious incident could easily result.
- If you need to slow down or stop while riding in the group please raise your left hand whilst doing so. Moving to the right hand side of the waterway will allow others to pass you.
- Have heaps of FUN and let's put on a great show of how awesome our sport and all the Jet Skiers really are!
- Bring this document with you on the day for reference should you need it.

Other legal requirements

By joining the ride you also agree to;

1. Accept as a condition of my entry in the Red Nose Ride Day, that my heirs, executors, administrators, hereby waive all and any claim rights or course of action which I or they might otherwise have for or arising out of the loss of my life or injury, damage or loss of any description whatsoever which I may suffer in the course of or consequent entry of participation in the said event.

This waiver releases and discharges and shall be and operate separately in favour of all persons, corporations and bodies involved or otherwise engaged in promoting or staging the said event and the servants, agents, representatives and officers or any of them and includes but is not limited to the committee of the Australian Jet Ski Association, affiliate organizers of the event, medical and paramedical practitioners and personnel, police officers, shire councils and shall operate whether or not the loss, injury or damage is attributed to the act or neglect of one or more of them.
3. I hereby indemnify the committee, the AJSA, event organizers, the members and the event volunteers against all suits, claims and demands whatsoever arising out of my participation in the said event.
4. I declare that I will abide by the event rules and will accept any of the organisers decisions as final.
5. I acknowledge that this declaration and indemnity applies to the participation of the above name in the said event.

8. I acknowledge that the Jet Ski I use in the activities is registered.
